Three parties were present:
God, Moses, and the people
of Israel.

The people said:
"נַעֲשֶׂה וְנִשְׁמָע"
we will do and we
will listen.

We watch and listen in awe
and fear.

The Torah was given with one
voice: God's.

The people stood with Moses.

The people purified
themselves for three days
prior this event.

Moses and the people stood
at Mount Sinai.

Three people are on the *Bimah* during the reading.

We say "Amen" to the בְּרָכָה before and after the reading.

There is no talking during the reading.

Only one person may read aloud at a time.

Some people have the custom of standing during the reading.

We do not let three days go by without reading the Torah.

The reader must be standing.
